

NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 383

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 383 will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, August 5, 2026, at 12:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Municipal Accounts & Consulting, L.P., 1281 Brittmoore Road, Houston, Texas 77043, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Receive comments from the public.
2. CONSENT AGENDA: The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event the item will be removed and placed on the Non-Consent Agenda.
 - a. Approve minutes.
 - b. Development in the District and elsewhere in Gleannloch Farms.
 - c. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections and payment of tax bills.
 - d. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills and review of investments.
 - e. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - i. billings, repairs and maintenance, customer correspondence, and message language on water bills; and
 - ii. sanitary sewer video inspection program and repairs.
 - f. District park matters, community improvement projects, and related coordination with community association.
 - g. Channel and pond maintenance, including detention and drainage facilities report.

 - aa. third water well;
 - bb. wastewater treatment plant improvements;
 - cc. water plant nos. 1 and 2 improvements;
 - dd. lift station nos. 1 and 2 improvements;
 - v. deeds, easements, execution of plats, consents to encroachment requests for annexation and/or service, utility commitment letters, and wastewater service contracts;
 - vi. capital improvement plan, including project funding;
 - vii. District drainage matters;
 - viii. NewQuest detention pond, including maintenance;
 - ix. update on preparation of bond application no. 13 and adopt Resolution Authorizing Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for Approval of Project and Bonds;
 - x. other engineering matters, including:
 - aa. nutria removal; and
 - bb. Boudreaux Road realignment, including approve Joint Participation Interlocal Agreement with Harris County, if appropriate.
