
HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 383

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 383 will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, August 7, 2024, at 12:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, Pecos Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Receive comments from the public.
2. CONSENT AGENDA: The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event the item will be removed and placed on the Non-Consent Agenda.
 - a. Approve minutes.

- xi. NewQuest detention pond; and
- xii. other engineering matters, including:
 - aa. nutria removal; and
 - bb. Boudreaux Road realignment.
